FOOD VENDOR – GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Note: Please keep this page for your records.

1. Food Vendors must complete, pay for, and have an executed application in order to access to Lake Superior Dragon Boat Festival (LSDBF) site as a Vendor.
2. LSDBF organizers reserve the right to select vendors based on proposed food and beverage items to be sold, sale price, space and utility needed, and past experience working at our festival.
3. LSDBF reserves the right to define garbage and recycling, which may include supplies and collection.
4. Following the application review process, selected vendors will receive two original agreement forms. A certificate of general liability insurance naming Harbortown, Superior Rotary, and Superior Sunrise Rotary Clubs as additional insured, 100% of the fee, and two signed agreement forms must be returned to the address listed on the agreement form by June 15th. If payment, certificates, and agreement forms are not received by the date specified, space will be sold to another vendor.
5. A fully executed agreement will be returned to the vendor. The agreement takes effect when both parties receive their copy and 100% of the fees have been paid, and a certificate of general liability insurance naming Harbortown, Superior Rotary, and Superior Sunrise Rotary Clubs as additional insured.
6. There will be no parking in the festival park/food area from 12:00 p.m. (Noon) Friday, August 27, 2010 until 8:00 p.m. Saturday, August 28, 2010. The only exception will be vehicles identified for tending purposes and identified on the agreement form. A window tag will be issued for designated vehicles and trailers only.
7. Electric hookup is limited, and therefore Vendor electrical power supply needs may also determine our ability to accommodate specific vendors. The reliability of electrical service provided by the LSBDF is not guaranteed and failure of service for any period of time does not constitute a breach of agreement by the LSBDF, and will not refund the application fee in cases of such occurrence.
8. Food Vendors must maintain strict compliance with all food related state and county health codes, and must provide upon request, a copy of their vendor license. The Festival will designate a Food Vending - Site Inspector(s) who will have authority to request changes in the operation or equipment. Health code concerns identified by the Festival Inspector must be corrected immediately. Failure to correct cited violations will result in cancellation of food vendor agreement, notification of state and county regulatory authorities, and loss of future vending agreements with the Lake Superior Dragon Boat Festival.
9. The Lake Superior Dragon Boat Festival reserves the right to amend or adopt general conditions at any time.
